

## Online Learning and Microsoft Teams

In the event of school closure or partial closure the following timetables will take immediate effect for those students directed to remain absent from school.

**From Monday January 11<sup>th</sup> the timetable will run in line with the usual school day with break at 10am and lunch at 12.25pm. All lessons will start at the times indicated on the timetables.**

Students in KS3 and KS4 will be set work for all their normal timetabled lessons. Live lessons, delivered over Microsoft Teams, will be given for a maximum of three hours per day, as set out in the timetables below. This is to try and ensure that young people are only using screens for a healthy amount of time every day. Work for all other lessons will be uploaded to the UAH (Lesson Board) in accordance with the remote learning policy.

Any issues accessing the VLE, emails or Microsoft Teams lessons can be quickly resolved by contacting the Form Tutor or relevant Learning Coordinator.

Citizenship education will be delivered using the resources available on the Oak National Academy Website.

The wellbeing and mental health of students will be supported through the use of guides and videos available on the Unifrog platform in addition to the wide range of resources signposted on the UAH website. (If a pupil has forgotten their password they can request a password reset by entering their school email address at [www.unifrog.org](http://www.unifrog.org)).

Careers education will be supported in all year groups through our Unifrog Blended Learning Plan, which incorporates remote learning activities. In addition to this pupils in year 11 will continue to be offered Careers, Advice and Guidance Interviews. These will be delivered by our independent careers advisor via Microsoft Teams.

**A model of a typical UAH timetable can be seen below:**

All students will receive 5 hours of learning which will include live and recorded lessons, and time for students to complete tasks independently.

Lessons in colour blocks will be delivered live over Microsoft Teams by class teachers.

Work for lessons in white blocks will be set on the VLE (Lesson Board). These will allow pupils to work independently.

## Sixth Form
