



SELECTION DAY

Selection is a two-way process which provides you with the opportunity to find out how you can start a fantastic training year with us. A typical day involves:

- Written task

- GCSE C or above* in Maths, English and Science (for Primary)
- UK Honours Degree*
- Successful completion of the Professional Skills Test in Literacy & Numeracy
- School experience we recommend you arrange time in school before an application

- The cost of the course is £9,000
- Student loans for tuition fees and maintenance loans are available*
- Bursaries are available depending on teaching subject and degree class*
