

CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

The one rule for all of us in the Academy is:

Everyone will act with courtesy, respect and consideration towards others at all times.

This means that:

1. I will not cause, or allow others to cause, physical or emotional hurt to anyone.
2. In lessons I will make it as easy as possible for everyone to learn.
3. I will speak politely and quietly and be silent whenever this is required of me.
4. I understand that I have a responsibility for the health and safety of everyone in the Academy community:
 - I will move sensibly and quietly about the Academy, keeping to the left;
 - I will be ready to help, for example by opening doors;
 - I will tell an adult if I see a situation which could be dangerous or unsafe;
 - I will not bring anything to the Academy which could cause harm, nuisance or danger to myself or others, e.g. personal stereos, cigarettes, chewing gum, aerosols etc.
 - I understand that my mobile telephone should not be seen or heard and that I must not use it to contact my parent/guardian during the Academy day, unless requested to do so by a member of staff.
5. I will respect the property of others.
6. I will help to keep the Academy clean and tidy so that it is a welcoming place we can all be proud of by:
 - putting all litter in bins;
 - keeping walls and furniture clean and unmarked;
 - taking great care of the displays, particularly of other pupils' work.
7. I understand that there will be no financial transactions or barter between pupils.
8. I will also remember that I am identified by my uniform, which should be correct both in and out of the Academy. Walking locally to and from the Academy, or with an Academy group, I need to be aware that the Academy's reputation depends on the way I behave.
