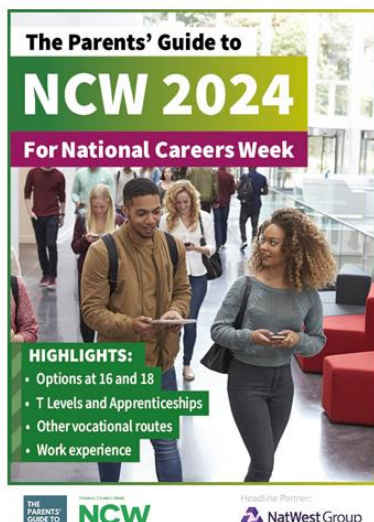
During the fair, they are running an exciting competition where **the most engaged, interactive student will win a prize** that could get them one step closer to their dream university course!
