
It is also completely normal to feel some stress at this time, so **take care of yourself:** get enough sleep, eat well, and talk to someone if you're feeling overwhelmed.

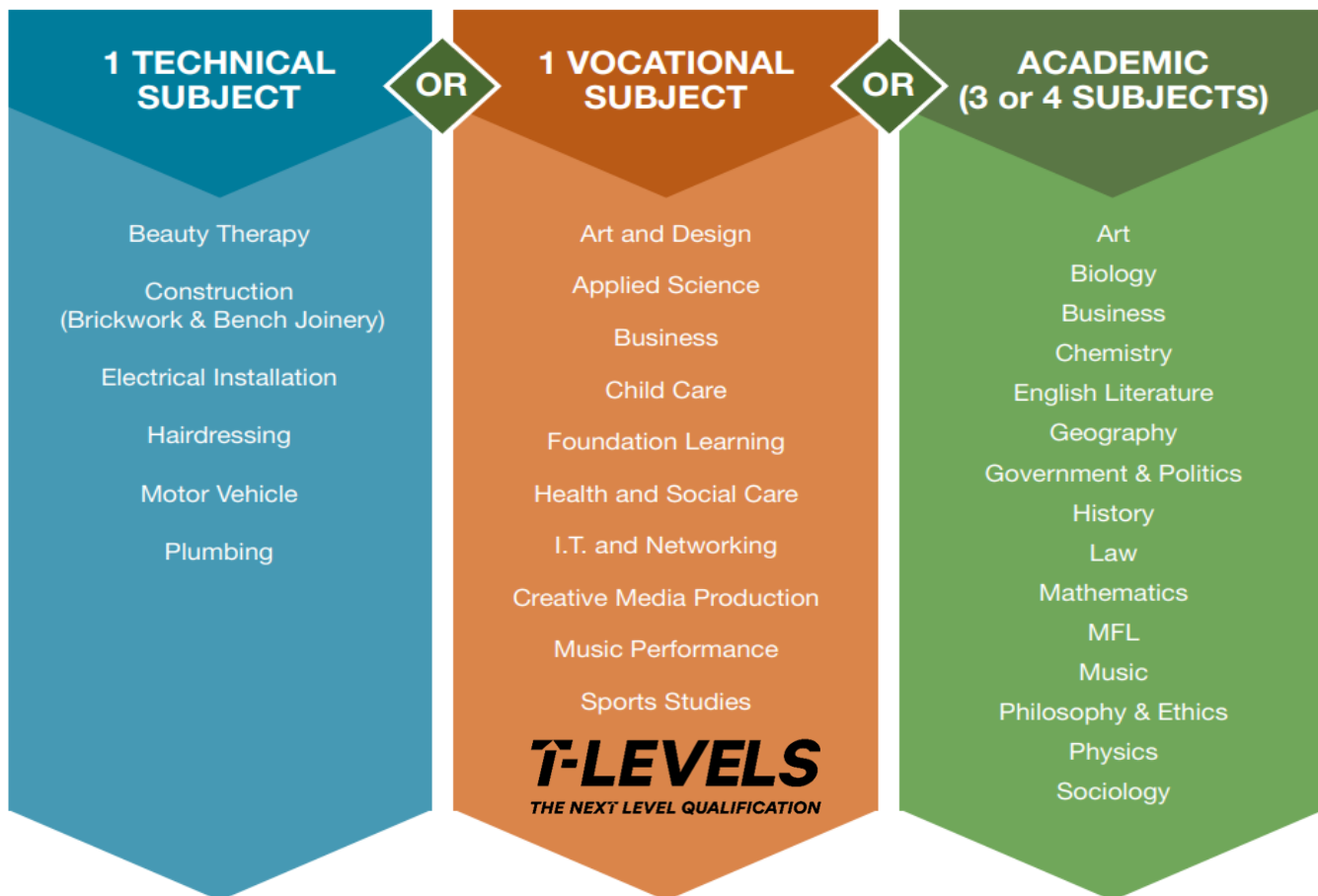


Our long-serving member of staff, Karen, has retired from the Apprenticeship office after many years of dedicated service.
